

Geneva man gets 25 years for drug crimes

A Geneva man received a 25-year prison sentence earlier this week after he pleaded guilty to two felony drug charges.

District Attorney Kirke Adams called 51-year-old Sam Turner a "longtime drug dealer," who pleaded guilty to felony unlawful possession of a controlled substance and felony first-degree possession of marijuana.

Geneva County Sheriff's investigators arrested Turner in May 2009 and charged him with trafficking marijuana and felony unlawful possession of a controlled substance. Adams said the trafficking charge was reduced to felony marijuana possession.

Adams said Turner received a 25-year prison sentence for the two class C felony crimes because he had three prior felony convictions on his criminal record.
