

Coffee Springs man wanted on multiple felony sex charges

Authorities are looking for a 49-year-old Coffee Springs man wanted on multiple felony charges, including production of child pornography.

Assistant Geneva County District Attorney Stephen Smith said a Geneva County grand jury returned three felony indictments in March against Quintin Leon Stokes. The indictments charged Stokes with first-degree rape, first-degree sodomy and sex abuse of a child under the age of 12.

According to a statement from District Attorney Kirke Adams' office, Stokes' last known address was on Long Branch Road in Geneva County. The statement also said authorities believe Stokes fled the area with his 17-year-old son, William Stokes. Smith said the allegations were investigated by the Geneva County Sheriff's Office.

He said after the indictments were returned, investigators uncovered additional evidence in the case from an analysis of Stokes' home computer. Smith said the additional computer evidence led to investigators recently filing charges of possession of child pornography and production of child pornography.

If convicted of the the rape and sodomy charges, Stokes faces 10 to 99 years or life in prison for each class A felony.
