## Two plead guilty to Ozark robberies

An Ozark teenager charged with robberies throughout the Wiregrass pleaded guilty to a first-degree robbery charge in Ozark Monday, according to authorities.

According to court records, Eunique Equality Laquan Brown, 17, of King Avenue in Ozark, pleaded guilty on Monday. A sentencing hearing is expected May 29.

According to authorities, Brown was one of at least three men believed to

have participated in a rash of burglaries in October in Coffee, Dale and Pike counties. During that time, a gas station at the intersection of Lakeview Road and U.S. 231 in Ozark was robbed.

In an unrelated case, Dale County District Attorney Kirke Adams said Jabari Petty, 21, of Oakhill Drive in Ozark, entered a "blind" plea to first-degree robbery on Monday.

According to records, Petty and another man held up two people on Larkin Street in July and demanded money.
