

# Slocomb man gets 25 years for rape, incest

Victim has Down syndrome

A Slocomb man pleaded guilty Monday to rape and incest involving a woman with Down syndrome.

According to a statement from the Geneva County District Attorney's Office, C.W. Green, 61, of Geneva County Road 30, pleaded guilty to the charges of first-degree rape and incest. Circuit Court Judge Kenneth Quattlebaum sentenced Green to serve 25 years for each of the charges as part of the plea agreement. Those sentences will run concurrently.

Geneva County District Attorney Kirke Adams said in the statement the victim was incapable of giving consent because she suffered from Down syndrome. Geneva County Sheriff's investigators arrested Green in August for the offenses, which happened on July 6. The Geneva County Department of Human Resources assisted in the investigation.

Assistant District Attorney Stephen Smith had said the charges stemmed from an incident that happened while the 28-year-old Geneva woman's legal custodian's were out of town. Smith

said Green had confessed to committing the sexual assaults, signing a written statement admitting to having sex on July 6.

"This guy is going where he needs to be — prison," Adams said.

Green faced 10 to 99 years or life in prison for the class A felony of first-degree rape and one to 10 years in prison for the class C felony of incest.
