

Reckless murder case headed to grand jury

The case of a man charged with reckless murder after the death of his friend was passed on to a Dale County grand jury on Wednesday.

Adam Matthew Brockett, 26, was charged in October after the truck he was driving wrecked, killing his passenger, Angela Piasecki of Dothan. The two were

traveling on Dale County Road 20 from a party where they celebrated Piasecki's 24th birthday, Dale County District Attorney Kirke Adams said.

Piasecki died about an hour after the wreck.

Authorities said Brockett was driving with a blood alcohol content that was twice the state's legal limit of .08. He posted a \$24,000 bond to get out of the

Dale County Jail.

His attorney, Bill Kominos, said Brockett had multiple fractures, including a potentially serious fracture in his back.

According to court records, Brockett had no previous criminal history. He could face up to life in a state prison for the Class A felony, if convicted.

A grand jury hearing is set for early next year.
