Samson woman charged with murder

On Dec. 28, 2013 at 1:50 p.m. 29-year-old Edward Andrews was pronounced dead at the scene of a domestic incident on South Bay Street in Samson. A person of interest in this incident was booked in the Geneva County Jail on unrelated charges. The Samson Police Department and the Alabama Bureau of Investigation investigated the case.

On Jan. 9, District Attorney Kirke Adams, Assistant David Rousseau and the Alabama Bureau of Investigation presented evidence to a Geneva County Grand Jury and a murder indictment was handed down.

On Jan. 10 40-year-old Felicia Ann Lane was charged with murder and is being held in the Geneva County jail, according to a news release from Samson Police Investigator Jimmy Hill.

Andrews was allegedly stabbed in the chest by Lane during an al-

tercation at their home with a small kitchen knife and died at the scene outside of the house that was in his name.

Samson Assistant Police Chief Darrell Smith said that Lane and Andrews had been involved in both verbal and physical domestic violence in the past.
