Lin pleads guilty to felony vehicular homicide

Chin Y. Lin of Crestview, FL pleaded guilty Thursday morning to felony vehicular homicide in the traffic death of Rebecca Howell Gilley on Aug. 20, 2012.

Lin pleaded guilty to running a stop sign at the intersection of County Roads 41 and 45 and striking Gilley's vehicle. Gilley died from her injuries in the wreck.

A hearing is scheduled on May 1 to determine if Lin would be eligible for probation, with a sentencing hearing to be scheduled for a later date. Lin could be sentenced to 1-5 years in a state prison and a fine of \$500-\$2,000.
