Four-year-old killed in crash

A single-vehicle crash Saturday night in Geneva County resulted in the death of a Midland City child. Eight other people were injured in the crash.

According to Alabama State Troopers, Zyrioh Tucker, 4, was killed when the 2003 Chevrolet



Avalanche in which she was a passenger left the roadway and overturned. The accident happened at about 6:55 p.m. near Geneva.

Tucker was not properly restrained at the time of the accident, according to police reports. Tucker was pronounced dead at the scene.

Alabama State Trooper Kevin Cook said the driver of the Avalanche, 32-year-old Starlea Nicole Knight, also of Midland City, was transported to a local hospital, where she is listed in critical condition. The seven remaining children were transported to local hospitals for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The Alabama State Troopers continue to investigate the accident.
