



Child killed in wreck

A single-vehicle crash at 6:55 p.m. Saturday, May 9, claimed the life of a Midland City child and injured eight others, according to the Alabama State Troopers. Zyrionh Tucker, 4, was killed when the 2003 Chevrolet Avalanche in which she was a passenger left the roadway and overturned. Tucker, who was not restrained, was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver of the Avalanche, 32-year-old Starlea Nicole Knight, also of Midland City, was transported to a local hospital, where she is listed in critical condition. The seven remaining children were transported to local hospitals for treatment of non-life threatening injuries. The crash occurred on Geneva Road 89 three miles east of Geneva.
