

Ozark man gets 30 years for store robbery

An Ozark man received a 30-year prison sentence after he recently pleaded guilty to the armed robbery of a local Dollar General store.

Dale County District Attorney Kirke Adams said Willie Lewis Johnson, 55, of Ice Street, pleaded guilty to a felony first-degree robbery charge last week.

Adams said Johnson, who had two prior felony convictions, received a 30-year prison sentence for the armed robbery charge in front of Circuit Court Judge William Filmore.

Ozark police charged Johnson with the armed robbery of the Dollar General store on East Avenue on Dec. 6, 2014.
