

One suspect wanted, one arrested in Ozark shooting

Ozark police have charged two 25-year-old men with attempted murder in connection to a shooting at the Ozark Villas apartments on Tuesday.

According to a statement from the Ozark Police Department, police have charged Lamar R. Griffin, 25, and Reginald Rogers, 25, both of Ozark, each with felony attempted murder.

Police are still looking for Griffin on his attempted murder charge.

The statement said the charges stemmed from Ozark police responding to the area of Ozark Villas apartments to a reported fight during which someone had been shot. Officers arrived and found a man suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim was taken to Dale Medical Center where he was listed in serious condition.
