•The Macon County Sheriff's Office seized 1,725 marijuana plants during a recent raid on the eastern side of the county. The seizure was based on a tip.

•Special agents with

the State Bureau of Investigations seized 2,034 marijuana plants during the first week of its annual eradication efforts, it was reported on June 16.

The annual effort takes about six weeks and is funded by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.
