Reward for Info on Death of Devon Willett

On June 23, 2015 officers from the Ozark Police Department were dispatched to the 1300 block of Willow Oaks Drive. The caller advised that a white male was lying on the floor unresponsive.

EMS personnel arrived on scene and transported the victim

to Dale Medical Center for treatment related to a gunshot wound. Medical physicians advised that the victim's condition is considered life threatening, and he was transferred to Southeast Alabama Medical Center in Dothan, Alabama for further treatment.

The victim in this case

has succumbed to the injuries sustained during this event. The victim's body will be sent to the Department of Forensic Sciences for further investigation to help determine the cause of death.

The victim is identified as: Devon Willett, white male, 54 years of age.

Law enforcement does

suspect foul play at this time and are still following up on leads, witnesses, and physical evidence.

At this time law enforcement authorities are offering a reward up to \$1000.00 to anyone that can provide information that leads to an arrest and/or conviction of the person(s) responsible for

this crime.
