A Geneva man has been arrested on sex abuse charges.

Capt. Ricky Morgan of the

Geneva Police Department reported Tuesday, June 30 that in March of 2015 the Geneva County Department of

Human Resources contacted the Geneva Police Department in reference to a sexual abuse complaint.

The alleged victim was an eight-year-old female. Through a joint investigation with the Southeast Alabama Child Advocacy Center and the Department of Human Resources an arrest warrant was issued for 46-year-old James Watson Campbell, AKA "Jimbo," of Geneva. On Tuesday Campbell turned himself into the Geneva County Jail and was later released on a \$25,000 bond.

eight children, including her own 4-year-old daughter who died.

Geneva County District Court Judge Stephen Smith found the prosecution had sufficient evidence in the criminal charges filed against 32-year-old Starlea Nicole Knight for her involvement in the fatal crash, which left seven children injured and her daughter dead. Smith forwarded the case to a grand jury for consideration of indictments.

Alabama State Troopers arrested Knight on May 12, shortly after she was released from Flowers Hospital, and charged her with murder and two counts of first-degree assault.

Troopers charged Knight with murder for the death of her 4-year-old daughter, Zyrioh Tucker, and felony assault for
