Former Geneva magistrate arrested on felony charges

Authorities arrested the former Geneva city magistrate and charged her with stealing more than \$2,500 during the time when she worked for the city.

Geneva County Sheriff Tony Helms said deputies booked Randi Crystal Glisson, 28, of Samson, into the Geneva County Jail on Monday on a felony first-degree theft of property charge. He said deputies only helped serve the felony warrant filed against Glisson, which was obtained by investigators by the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency.

Glisson, charging her with felony first-degree theft of property.

Glisson is charged with stealing more than \$2,500, which constitutes a felony charge, from the City of Geneva while Glisson served as the then city magistrate. ALEA took over the investigation from the Geneva Police Department.

Glisson is free on \$25,000 bail.
