At a press conference Thursday, Geneva Police Chief Tony Clemmons said that officers were looking for the residence when Davis flagged them down. He told police that Hel-

mers was not breathing and CPR was attempted. Geneva County Coroner Hagler Ward said that Helmers was pronounced dead that evening at Wiregrass Medical Center.

to the Geneva County Jail. Lead investigator, Capt. Ricky Morgan of the Geneva Police Department, said that the preliminary autopsy on Thursday by the state Department of Forensics showed that Helmers died of strangulation. Warrants were signed on

Davis Friday morning, Morgan said, and he appeared before District Judge Stephen Smith on the same day. Smith set bail at \$250,000. Investigation continues into the incident.
