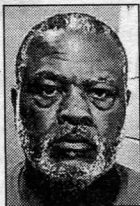


Judge denies probation for man convicted of child porn charges

A Dale County judge denied a Level Plains man his request for probation Tuesday, ordering him to prison for multiple child pornography convictions.

Court records show Circuit Court Judge Kimberly Clark denied the probation request made by 55-year-old Coolidge Brown Jr. and ordered him to serve his 10-year sentence in the state Department of Corrections. Brown pleaded guilty last month to nine felony child porn possession charges.

Deputies arrested Brown in February 2015 as part of a Dale County Sheriff's Office investigation. The charges stemmed from investigators serving a search warrant at Brown's Level Plains home where they found and seized numerous pornographic images of a minor.
