## Ozark man gets 50 years for rape of mom, 8-year-old girl

A Dale County judge sentenced an Ozark man to 50 years in prison for the

abductions and sexual assaults of an 8-year-old girl and her mother. District Attorney Kirke Adams said Cir-

cuit Court Judge Kimberly Clark sentenced 45-year-old David Luverne Pitts for seven felony charges, which included a 50-year

prison term for first-degree rape. Adams said the adult victim tes-

tified during the sentencing hearing.

yond the borders of a report."

The abduction and sexual assault occurred July 24, 2014.

Former Ozark Police Chief Tony Spivey told the Dothan Eagle the suspect was already inside the victim's home after she had returned from being out.

Spivey told the Eagle the victim told police she and the girl were taken to a secluded area off Alabama Highway 123 North where they were held throughout the night and sexually assaulted.

Spivey said Pitts was armed with a knife and gun during the assault and abduction.

"I do want to thank law enforcement involved because after the crime was committed, the defendant fled to south Florida. It took really good law enforcement coordination to locate him and bring him back to Dale County where he would face justice," Adams said. "There's no sentence the court could've given to take away

what the victims went through, but certainly for the safety of the community, it was a very satisfying sentence for the state of Alabama and the citizens of Dale County."

Court records show Clark sentenced Pitts to 50 years for firstdegree rape, 20 years for firstdegree burglary, 20 years for sex abuse of a child less than 12 years old, 15 years each for two counts of second-degree kidnapping, 15 years for first-degree theft of property and 10 years for firstdegree criminal mischief. All the sentences were ordered to be served concurrently and with the 50-year rape sentence.
