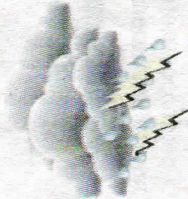

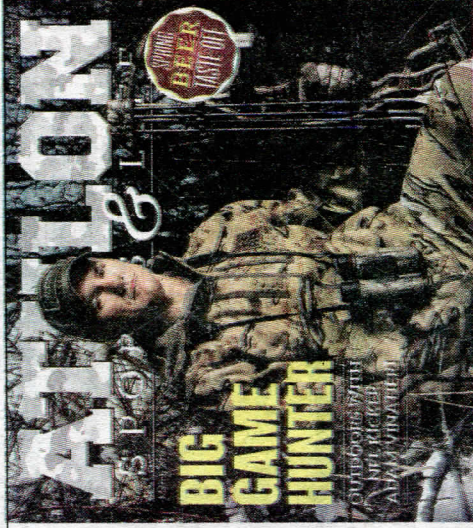

Teen pleads guilty to fatally shooting friend

A Slocomb teenager has pleaded guilty to manslaughter for fatally shooting his friend while playing with a handgun.

Geneva County District Attorney Kirke Adams said 17-year-old Joshua Gianni

Haire recently pleaded guilty to a felony manslaughter charge in front of Circuit Court Judge Kimberly Clark.

Agents with the State Bureau of Investigation of the Alabama Law Enforcement

Agency arrested Haire on April 24, 2015, and charged him with murder.

Adams said Haire, who was 16 at the time of the offense, pleaded guilty to fatally shooting his friend, 26-year-old Demetrius Fryer, at a residence on Mulberry
