Man Gets 18 Years in Manslaughter

Daleville resident Johnny Draugh, 56, was sentenced to 18 years in prison after he pled guilty to the February 11, 2007, manslaughter of 47-year-old Ronnie Miller, an Ohio native who was working as a contractor at Fort Rucker.

The murder occurred at Draugh's home after Miller, along with his brotherin-law, arrived to discuss a truck title owed to the brother-in-law.

When an argument ensued in the front yard of Draugh's residence in the VFW Mobile Home Park, Draugh stabbed Miller once in the heart. At the time, both men were highly intoxicated, District Attorney Kirke Adams said.
